



PEPPER SPRAY RESTRICTIONS

Arkansas	Product canisters not to exceed 150 cc or 5.07 oz
D.C.	Registration form must be completed at purchase and vendor must collect and forward form to the Metropolitan Police Department.
California	Product canisters not to exceed 2.5 oz
Florida	Product canisters not to exceed 2 oz
Hawaii	Retailer must be licensed to sell. Honolulu: OC only (SABRE RED) is legal. Size restriction: 0.5 oz
Massachusetts	License Requirement to carry and purchase. Can only be sold by licensed firearms dealers.
Michigan	CS Tear Gas canisters cannot exceed 1.25 oz. Red pepper sprays cannot exceed 10% Oleoresin Capsicum. Blended sprays are not allowed.
Nevada	Products which contain CS tear gas are regulated - items containing OC only or OC combined with other compounds or dyes other than CS are not regulated.
New Jersey	Product canisters not to exceed 0.75 oz.
New York	Certificate must be completed during purchase and no more than 2 canisters can be sold to a consumer. Forms must be kept on file for inspection by State Police. Can only be sold by licensed firearms dealers and licensed pharmacists. Product canisters not to exceed 0.75 oz and strength not to exceed 0.7% Major Capsaicinoids.
North Carolina	Product canisters not to exceed 150 cc or 5.07 oz.
South Carolina	Product canisters not to exceed 50 cc or 1.69 oz.
Wisconsin	Red pepper sprays cannot exceed 10% Oleoresin Capsicum. Blended sprays are not allowed.
